



(LEFT) Metropolitan Topeka (Kansas) Airport has taken delivery of a 2006 Emergency One TITAN HPR 4X4 crash truck. The vehicle carries 1500 gallons of water, 105 gallons of foam and is equipped with a Hale 1500 gpm pump. It is powered by a Detroit Diesel Series 60 665HP engine and a Twin Disc transmission.

(RIGHT) SIDES has recently delivered the first VMA 135 type crash tender for Kansai Airport in Japan. It is one of five vehicles to be supplied by SIDES.
